Important Reminders

Snacks- We really appreciate a weekly donation of fruit, vegetables, crackers, breadsticks, raisins etc. The children help prepare and cut the fruit at snack time encouraging independence. (They then enjoy washing up afterwards!)



Water Bottles- Please remember your child's water bottle for every session.

Spare Clothing- Having a change of clothes at Amber is really handy in case of any accidents, getting wet during water play or spillages at snack/lunchtime.



Named Items- Please label everything that belongs to your child.

Toys- Please discourage your child from bringing toys from home as we cannot be held responsible if they get lost or damaged. Thank you.

Messy Play- We do a lot of messy play at Amber, please dress your child in clothes you don't mind getting dirty.



Sickness- In the event your child has sickness or diarrhoea, please do not return to Amber until 48 hours after their last episode. Please either send a text message or call to inform us your child will not be at Amber.

Forest School- Now the weather is warming up, it is a good idea to dress your child in light loose trousers and long sleeves due to stinging nettles, brambles and in some cases ticks. Wellies are useful in case we go for a paddle in the stream. We stay in the shade as much as possible. Please also bring a spare pair of shoes/clothes if your child stays for the afternoon session.

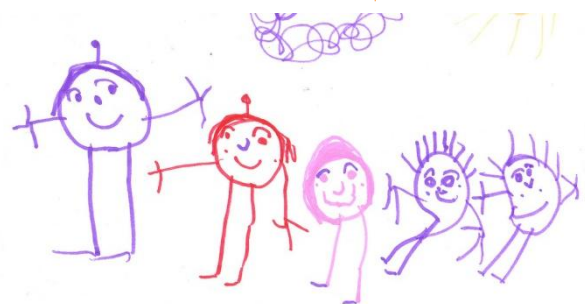
